

## MSCCSP Releases Updated Maryland Sentencing Guidelines Manual and Offense Table (Effective January 2008)

The Maryland State Commission on Criminal Sentencing Policy (MSCCSP) has revised the Maryland Sentencing Guidelines Manual for clarity and ease-of-use. The new manual has been reorganized and the MSCCSP has:

- Added a chapter explaining special applications of the guidelines (Chapter 10);
- Added sample worksheets so that users can see how to accurately complete the worksheet (Chapters 10 and 16);
- Added a chapter with a list of frequently asked questions and their respective answers (Chapter 15);
- Clarified proper calculation of prior adult record (Chapter 7).

Additionally, the MSCCSP has revised the Guidelines Offense Table (Appendix A of the Maryland Sentencing Guidelines Manual) to reflect: (1) changes to the seriousness categories for select offenses, (2) new offenses passed by the General Assembly, and (3) edits, including updated CJIS codes and a reorganization of handgun and weapon offenses. These changes were submitted to the Code of Maryland Regulations (COMAR) and were adopted **effective January 1, 2008**.
