






CHARACTERISTICS OF PROPERTY OFFENSES

CIRCUIT VERSUS DISTRICT COURT – FELONY THEFT OFFENSES

Felony theft offenses in Maryland, as defined in Criminal Law Article, §§ 7-104 and 7-105, are unique in that they may be prosecuted in either the District Court or circuit courts, regardless of the dollar amount involved in the theft.





SENTENCES AND ECONOMIC LOSS FOR FELONY PROPERTY OFFENSES IN MARYLAND CIRCUIT COURTS

Terms to Know	
Statutory Maximum	Maximum incarceration allowed by Maryland law
Total Sentence	Includes jail/prison time, credit for time served, home detention, and suspended time
Guidelines-Applicable Sentence	Includes jail/prison time, credit for time served, and home detention
	Does <u>not</u> include suspended time
Post-Sentence Incarceration	Period of incarceration served after sentencing
	Does <u>not</u> include credit time or suspend all but time served sentences
